When is the Walk & Run for Life?

April 4, 2020

Where do I go?

John Prince Park, located at 4759 S. Congress Avenue, Lake Worth, FL 33461. Please use the South Congress entrance.

What time does it start?

The 5K registration starts at 6:30AM, run starts at 7:30AM.
Fundraisers check-in starts at 8:00AM. The Walk starts at 9:00AM.

How many people are going to be there?

We typically have over 1,000 people in attendance.

What is the distance and route of the Walk?

The Walk is 1.5 miles. It starts off by the Center Drive Pavilion, goes north on the paved walking path and returns on the Heart Trail which is mulched.

Will I be able to push my stroller through the mulch?

A jogging stroller will have no problem on the mulch. There will be a paved way back for those who cannot walk on the mulched Heart Trail.

What is the route of the 5K?

It starts on Prince Drive due south of the Pavilion, turns right onto Center Drive, turns right at the boat ramp, and comes back on a paved sidewalk.

Can I run the 5K with a stroller?

Yes! However as a courtesy to other runners we ask that you start in the back of the pack.

How much does it cost to walk?

It's free! Keep in mind this is a fundraising event, so please consider raising pledges or making a donation the day of the event. Win fun prizes as you raise funds.

How much is the 5K?

Register online in advance for discounted pricing. If you register the morning of the event, the fee will be \$40.

What should I bring?

Your fundraising forms and any money you have collect, comfortable shoes, a hat, sunscreen, and a fun-loving attitude.

Where should I park?

There is plenty of parking, both paved and on the grass. Enter the park through the South Congress entrance, follow the road and the main parking lot will be on the left. There will be signs and parking attendants to get you to the right place.
